**ORDER REGARDING DOCKET FILING**  
**FOR ALL CASES**


Case Management Orders 1 and 9 established certain rules governing how documents would be filed in this case. This order changes those rules and establishes new rules for how documents will be filed. This order applies only to filings made from this point forward; documents previously filed do not need to be re-filed in accordance with this order. This order applies going forward to all producer and non-producer cases, including all cases that will be tried here as well as all cases that will be remanded.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that, for all cases in this MDL, all documents filed with the court shall be docketed in the main 4:06MD1811 case.

Additionally, counsel may continue to file notices of depositions in the main 4:06MD1811 case.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that pleadings (as defined in Rule 7(a), Fed. R. Civ. P.) and any motions or other documents directed to pleadings – for example, motions to dismiss, motions to remand, motions to amend, motions for

summary judgment, or any briefs or exhibits related or responding to such motions – shall be filed in both the main 4:06MD1811 case and in the individual civil case(s) to which the filing relates. Other items – for example, documents relating to discovery or scheduling matters – are not to be filed in the individual civil cases.
