




# Connecting to the Courtroom Wi-Fi Network

The Network Name (SSID) will be the current courtroom you are in. For example - Your hearing is scheduled to be held in Courtroom 3N; you will want to look for the Wi-Fi Network named **3N**.

The Courtroom Wi-Fi Networks uses WPA2 - Personal AES Security Setting.

The password for the Courtrooms' Wi-Fi Network can be obtained from the Courtroom Deputy.

## Connecting an iPad to the Courtroom Wi-Fi

<p>1. Find the <b>Settings</b> Icon on the home screen</p>	
<p>2. Select the <b>Wi-Fi</b> Setting from the list on the left. Look for the Wi-Fi Network you would like to connect to. For this example we are in Courtroom 5S for our hearing, so we will select the <b>5S</b> Network from the list.</p>	
<p>3. Once we select the Network we wish to join, we will be asked for the password. Passwords can be obtained from the Courtroom Deputy on duty. Enter the <b>Password</b> and then click <b>Join</b>.</p>	
<p>4. A <b>Check</b> will appear next to the Network Name while the iPad is connected to that select Wi-Fi Network.</p>
